Will you be merciful to all, show compassion to the poor and strangers, and defend those who have no helper?

The Second Week: Pray for the Diocese.

Consider: The Bishop is called to guard the faith, unity and discipline of the Church.

O God, by your grace you have called us in this Diocese of Ottawa to a goodly fellowship of faith. Bless him who is to be our Bishop, the other clergy and all the people. Grant that your Word may be truly preached and truly heard, your sacraments faithfully administered and faithfully received. By your Spirit, fashion our lives according, to the example of your Son, and grant that we may show the power of your love to all among whom we live; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Amen.

4. WHOM SHALL I SEND? -Remembering The One Who Will Be Chosen

Loving God, Give your grace to the one who will be called and appointed to be the ministry of being bishop/Incumbent. May he/she be guided by the Holy Spirit to hear your call. Fill him/her with the truth of your Gospel and the skill and courage to proclaim it. May he/she faithfully serve you to your glory and for the benefit of the whole people of God.

5. OPENING TO THE SPIRIT - Affirming The Leading Of The Holy Spirit

O God the source of all things, you call us through baptism to discipleship with Jesus Christ, and send us to proclaim to all people the good news of your gracious and loving rule. Inspire by your Holy Spirit the hearts of many to offer themselves for the ordained ministry of your Church, that with faithful courage and generosity of heart they may build up your people in this diocese to your glory and for the sake of the world you love; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O God, we pray for the Church in this diocese, that faithful women and men respond to the call to service and leadership: the Lord grant us discernment in selecting those who would lead us.
